**To apply:**

Send a letter to Wendy Bulloch, Executive Director of LPM, on or before Friday September 17.

Explain why you believe you should be selected for the conference and how attending the conference would benefit the work you do as a practitioner.

*The selected candidate will be advised of the selection by Friday September 24<sup>th</sup>, 2010.*

**If you are selected you will be required to:**

- present a report on highlights of learning, using a power point, at the November 16<sup>th</sup> Literacy Partners of Manitoba Annual General Meeting in Winnipeg.

- provide a minimum of two training sessions to other practitioners in urban and rural Manitoba by May 1, 2011. (LPM will cover travel costs for you to travel outside of Winnipeg if you are an urban practitioner and to Winnipeg if you are a rural practitioner.)

The chosen candidate will provide their own transportation to and from the Winnipeg airport and is responsible for any extended health costs/insurance you require for out of province travel.

Wendy Bulloch, LPM's Executive Director will also be attending the conference.
